eFiling

The Pinellas County Clerk's office, along with Clerk's statewide, has supported the Florida eFiling Authority in the development of the statewide eFiling portal. As of January 1, 2011, the portal became operational allowing for the eFiling of cases through a single point of entry. To date, the counties that have started accepting eFiling in various divisions of the court include Lake, Columbia, Duval, Gulf, Holmes, Lee, Miami-Dade, Putnam, and Walton counties. In the next round of counties to move forward are Broward, Orange, Marion, Collier, Franklin, Jackson, and Leon counties. Pinellas County is scheduled to begin eFiling in the Probate area within a target date of mid-summer.
